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
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Boneless Bodies

They have two fins, eight arms, and two **tentacles**.


The arms and tentacles look alike.

is called a pen. It helps
the body keep
its shape.



Arrows of the Sea

Some people call squids "sea arrows."

A squid's body is shaped like an arrow.

Also, like an arrow, a squid can move very quickly.

The fastest squids can shoot through the sea at about 25 miles per hour (40 kph).







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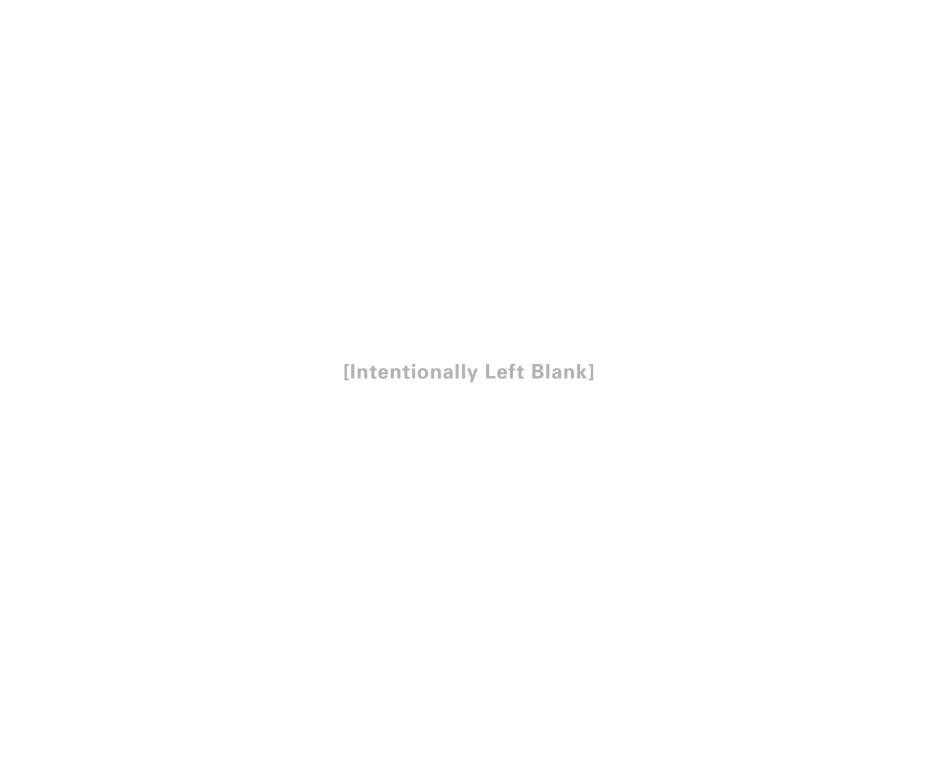
