

On February 4, 2007, the Indianapolis
Colts faced off against the Chicago Bears
in **Super Bowl** XLI (41). The Bears earned
a quick lead by scoring a **touchdown**on the very first play of the game. Colts **quarterback** Peyton Manning knew he
would need to help his team even the score.
Would he be able to rise to the challenge?

A Bears player makes the first touchdown. The early touchdown was the fastest score in Super Bowl history. It happened about 14 seconds into the game!







Super Bowl Hero

Peyton knew exactly how to take back control of the game. A few minutes after the Bears' touchdown, he threw an incredible 53-yard (48.5 m) touchdown pass to teammate Reggie Wayne. The Colts were back on track! For the rest of the game, Peyton was on fire. He completed 25 out of 38 passes and gained 247 yards (226 m). His fantastic plays helped lead the Colts to a 29–17 win. Peyton and his teammates were **NFL** champions!
