So Long!

The reticulated (ri-TIK-yoo-*lay*-tid) python is the longest snake in the world.



An adult reticulated python can be as long as two cars.

Adult male reticulated pythons can grow to be 33 feet (10 m) long. They can weigh more than 400 pounds (181 kg).

Reticulated pythons live in the woods and **rain forests** of Southeast Asia.


They are found in hot, wet places near rivers, lakes, and ponds.

They can also be found crawling through trees and bushes.
