






Nobody wins like Brett Favre. From 1991 through 2009, he racked up an NFL record of 181 victories—50 more than any other **active** quarterback! Most of these wins came in the 16 seasons that he spent with the Green Bay Packers.

Brett retired from the NFL in 2008, but then quickly changed his mind. He loved football too much to quit. He returned to the game first with the New York Jets in 2008 and then with the Minnesota Vikings in 2009.

Incredibly, Brett's right arm still showed the same zip that it had when he'd entered the league nearly 20 years earlier. Behind its power, the Vikings made it into the 2009–2010 playoffs and a meeting with the Dallas Cowboys. How did the game with Dallas turn out? A win for Brett and Minnesota, naturally!


