


The Beaver's Lodge

4. piles of mud and chemical paste that beavers build to communicate with other animals
6. a hidden supply of food that is stored for later use
8. to come together to have young
11. animals that hunt other animals for food
13. a family of beavers; it includes an adult pair that mates, and their young
14. people who design and construct buildings
15. to overflow with water
16. a strong barrier built across a stream or river to hold back water
