Trapped in a Fire!



When the deputy drove to the address, he found the house **engulfed** in fire. Flames crawled up the walls and roof, and thick smoke poured out of the windows. Deputy Mays reported the fire to the **dispatcher** and then checked inside the home. That's when he heard Patsy Smith screaming for help.

Soon, a second deputy arrived at the house with gas masks. Deputy Mays put a mask on and raced into the smoke-filled kitchen. He grabbed Patsy and quickly pulled her out of the house. The victim was badly burned. However, thanks to the deputy's brave rescue, she survived the terrible blaze.



After the rescue, Baldwin County Sheriff Bill Massee praised his deputy. "I am extremely proud of Deputy Mays," he said. "I'm not surprised that he would confront a fire to save a life. He is a person who was not going to let someone die."
