
Unlikely Athlete

Troy wore casts to straighten his feet and legs. As he got older, he wore special shoes, even while he was sleeping.


As soon as Troy's feet and legs were straight, he started running around and playing sports. He grew to love basketball, baseball, and football. Big and strong, he was good at all three.
