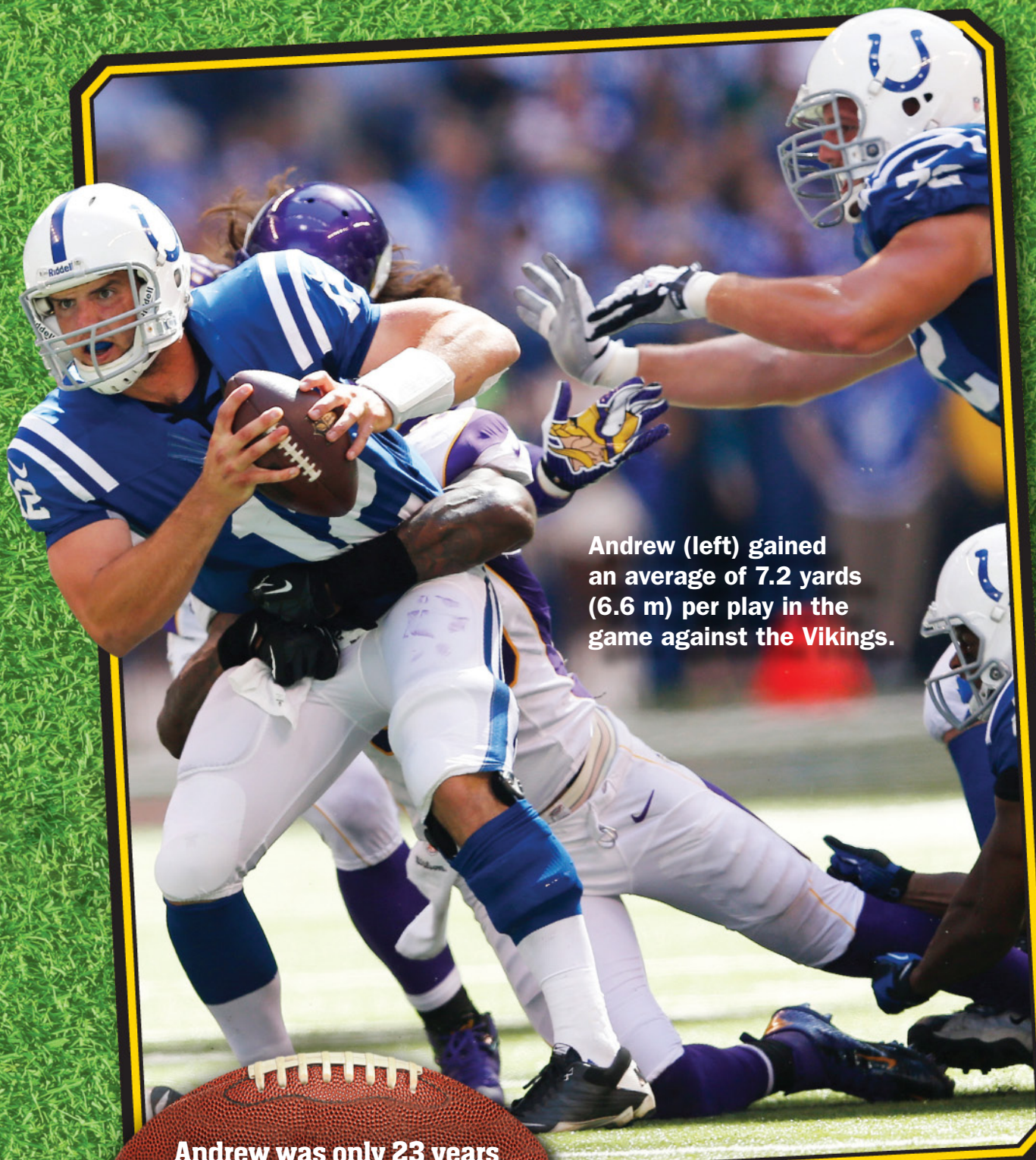


Running Out of Time

Andrew (left) gained an average of 7.2 yards (6.6 m) per play in the game against the Vikings.


Andrew was only 23 years old when his team battled the Vikings in 2012.

The First Win


On the next play, Andrew pretended to call for a **snap**. He tricked the Vikings into moving **offside**. This **penalty** allowed the Colts to move five yards (4.6 m) closer to the end zone. Because of Andrew's smart play, the team could try for a **field goal**. Andrew's teammate, Adam Vinatieri, kicked the ball. It sailed through the goalposts. Score! Andrew's quick thinking had helped lead to his first win in the NFL.

Growing up as the son of an NFL player, Andrew Luck had a lot to live up to in his own football career. Amazingly, he proved himself to be better than anyone could have imagined.
