# Glossary

**ape (AYP)**

An animal from a group that includes orangutans, chimpanzees, bonobos, gorillas, and gibbons. Apes are very smart animals.

**poisonous (POI-zuhn-uhss)**

Able to harm or kill an animal or person.

**rain forest (RAYN FOR-ist)**

A thick forest of tall trees and other plants where lots of rain falls.

**vine (VINE)**

A plant with long, thin, bendy stems that grows up from the ground and gets tangled in trees.
