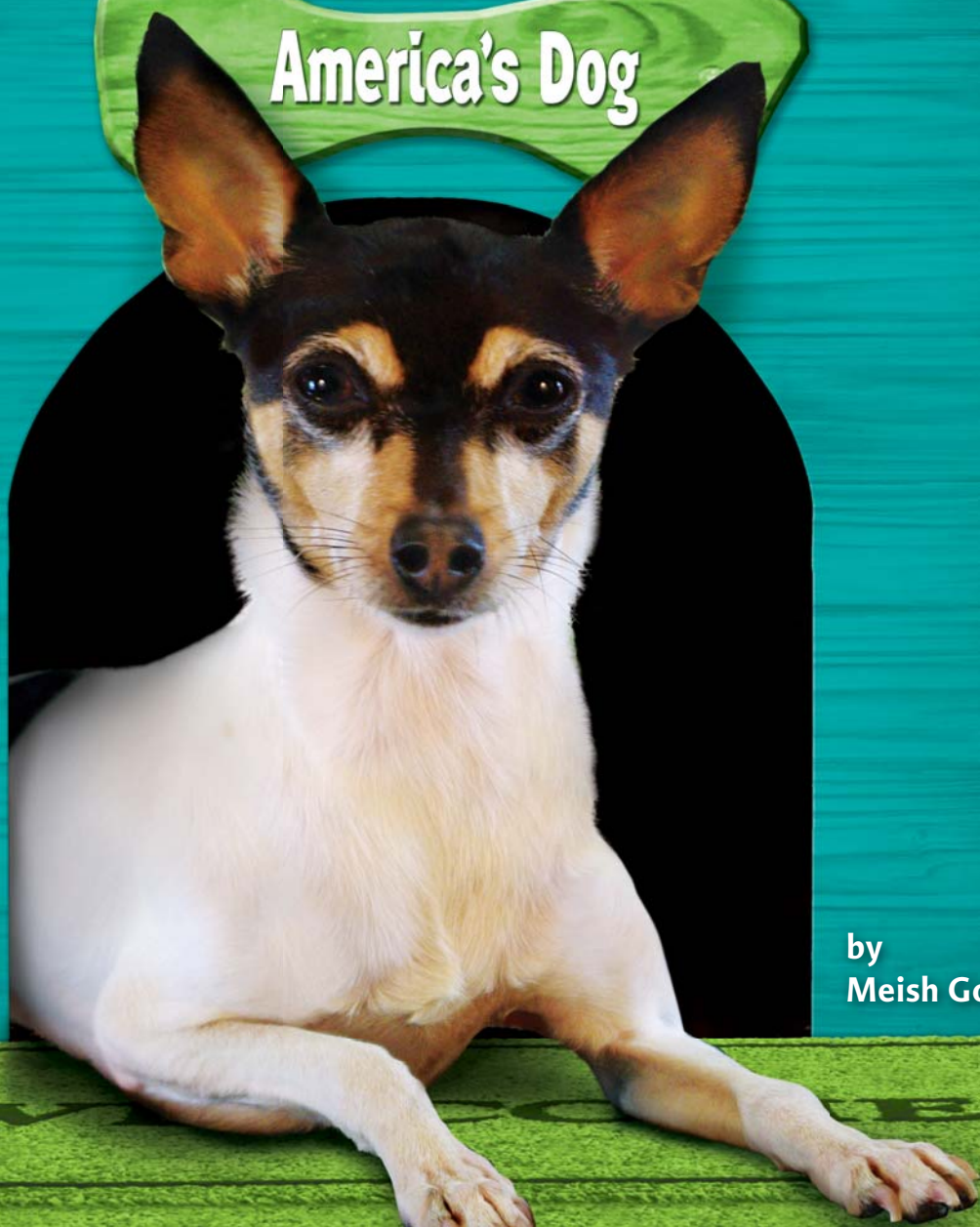

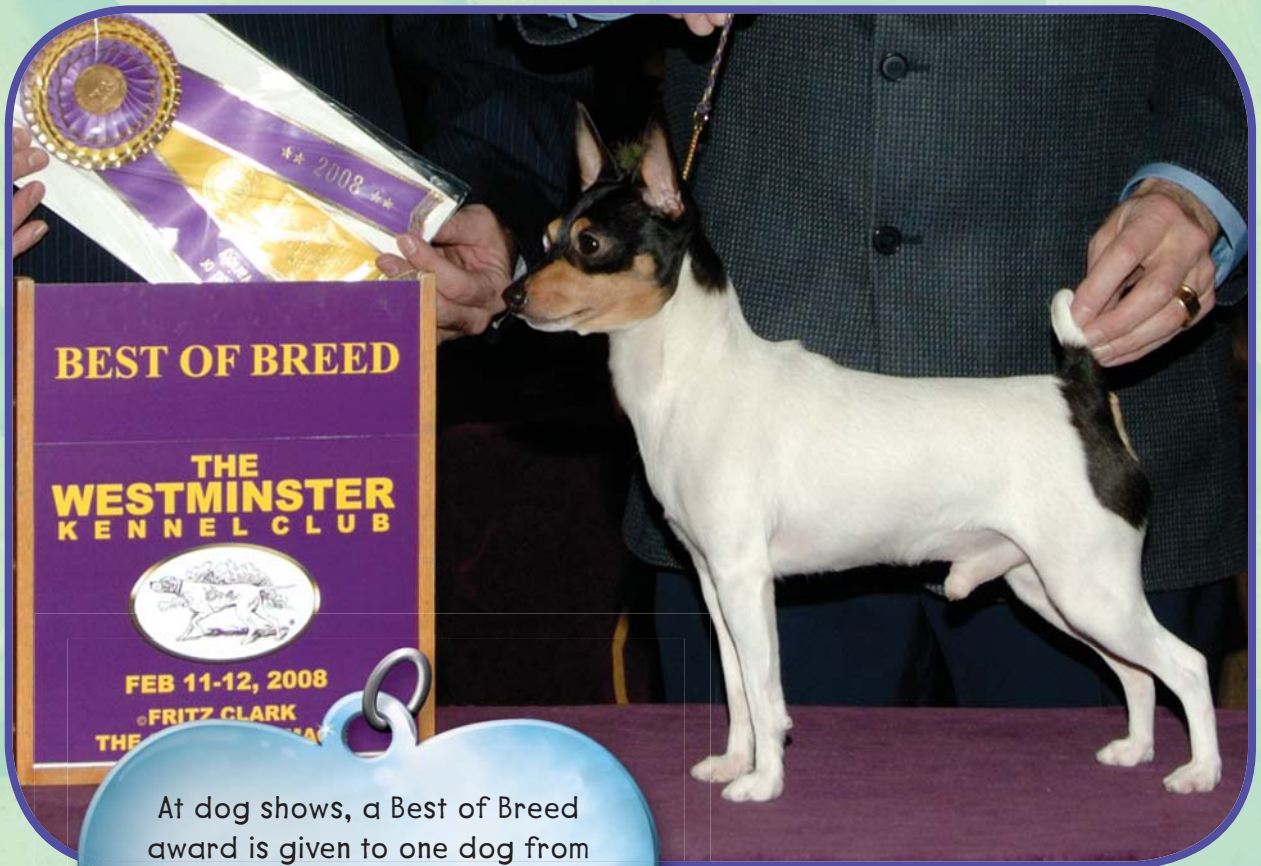

Dana was proud of Kasey's victory. Yet he never imagined what would happen next. Kasey was chosen to be pictured on cans of a new brand of dog food. The food company loved how the tiny terrier looked. Now Kasey was more than just a winning show dog. He was a star model, too!

All in the Family

The Best of Breed prize was a big honor for Kasey. Yet he wasn't the first member of his family to win the award. His father, Valcopy Butch Cassidy, had taken the same prize at Westminster four years earlier, in 2004. That's a family of champions!

When Kasey won, however, he received an extra reward that his father did not. He got to meet superstar race car driver Kasey Kahne—the person for whom the toy fox terrier was named. It was a special moment for both the dog and the driver!



When Kasey won the Best of Breed prize in 2008, one of the dogs he beat out was his own sister, Penelope Pit Stop. She placed second in the toy fox terrier group.
