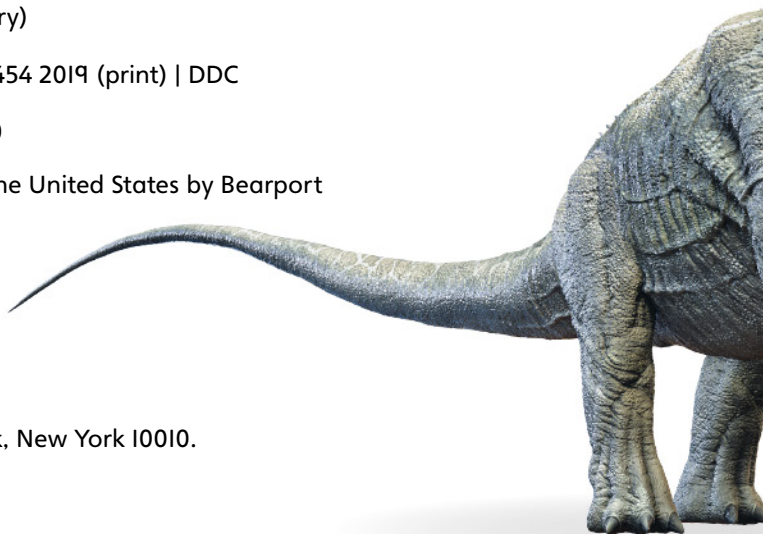

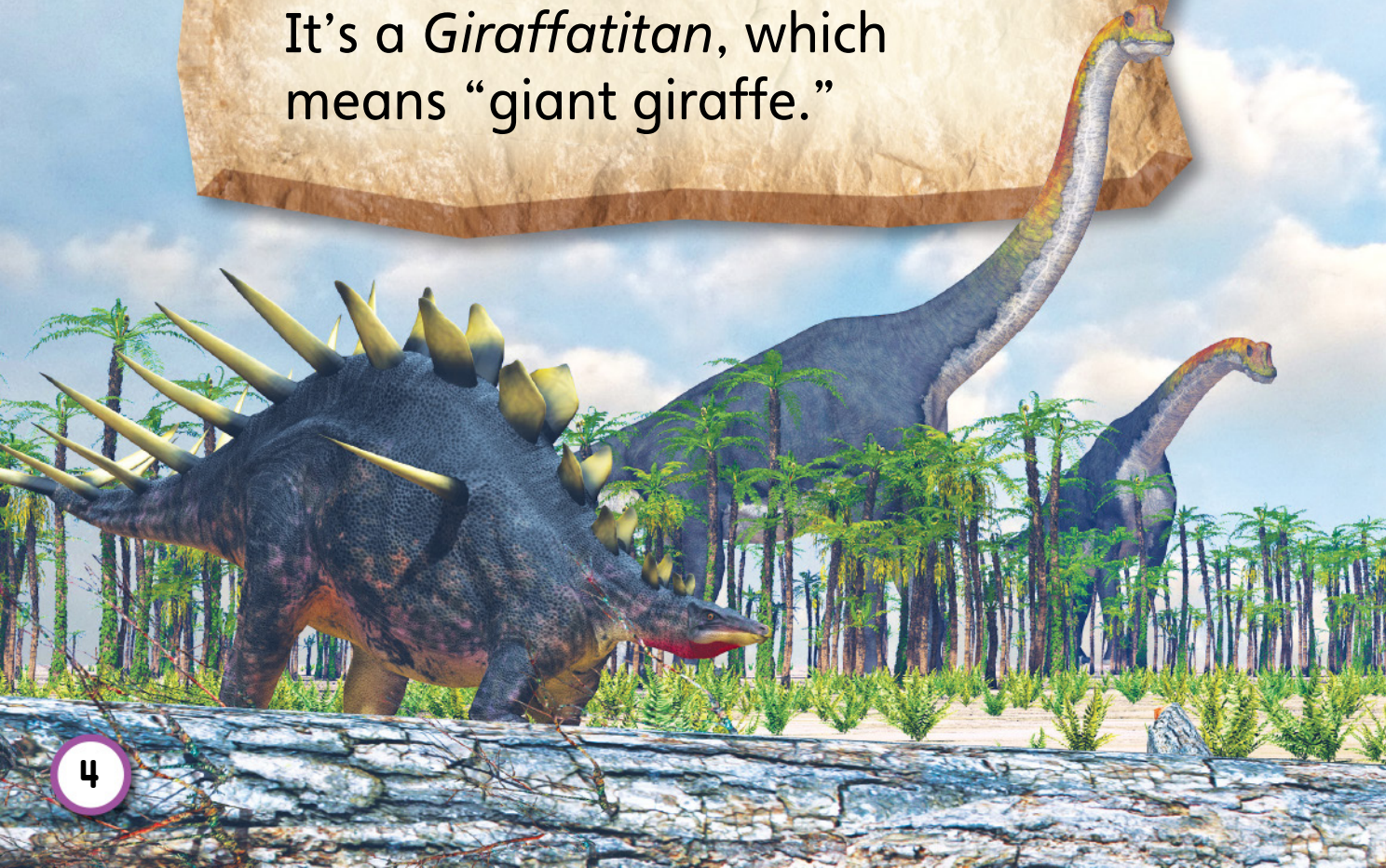
# Super Tall

Some **scientists** think *Diplodocus* cracked its tail like a whip.

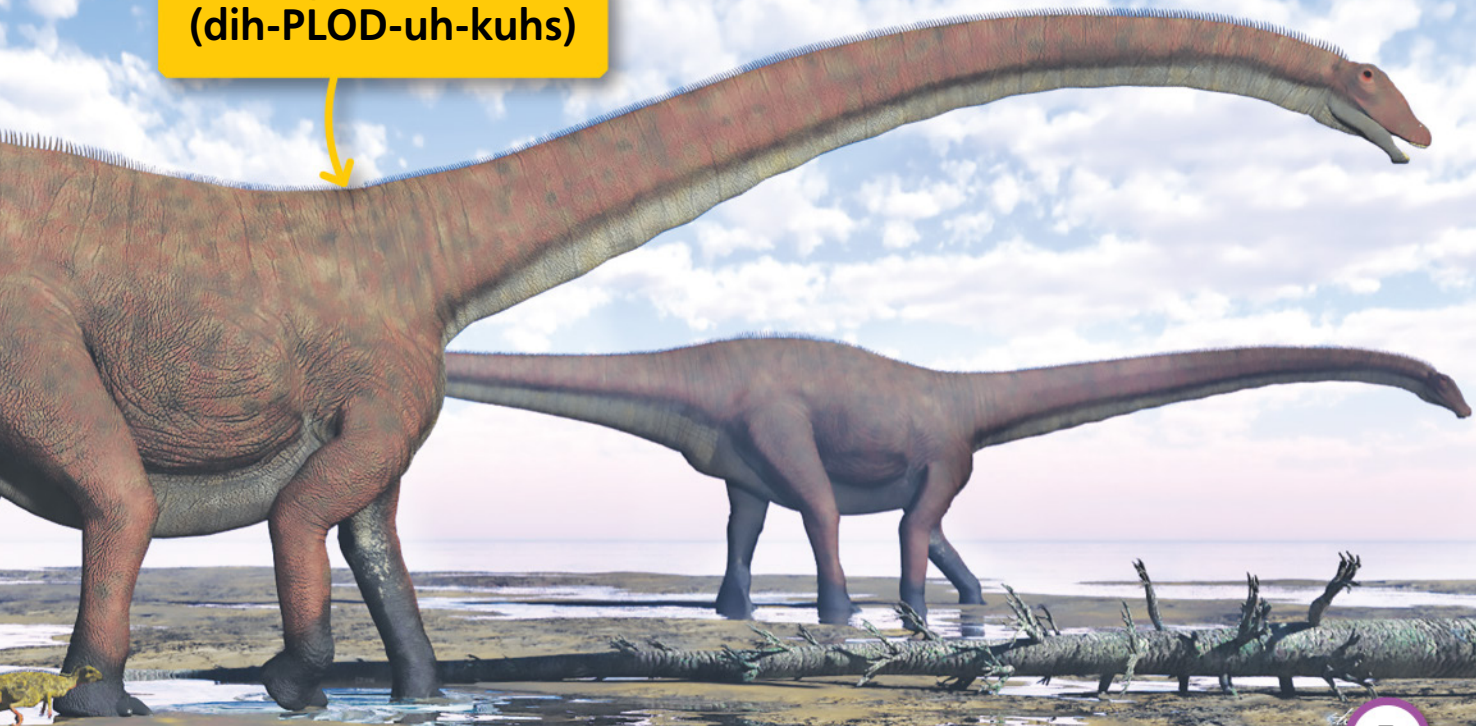
It may have done this to scare away enemies.

Ruth Owen has been developing and writing children's books for more than ten years. She first discovered dinosaurs when she was four years old—and loves them as much today as she did then!



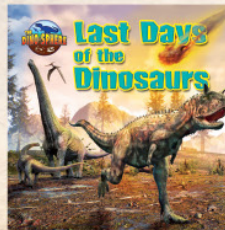
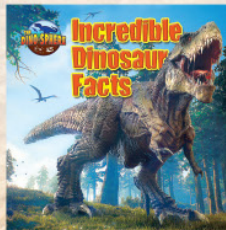
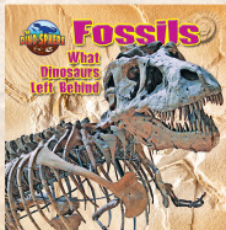
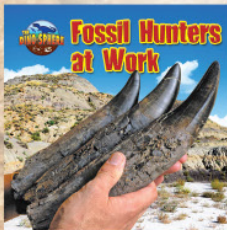
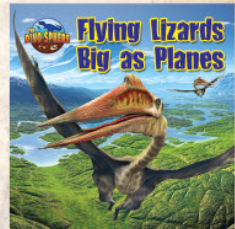
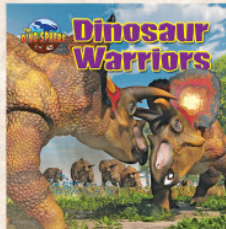
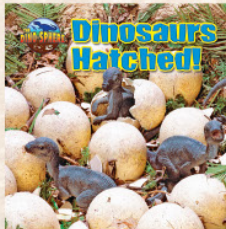
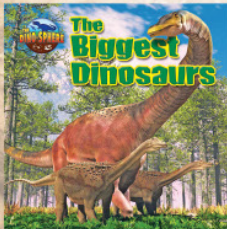
