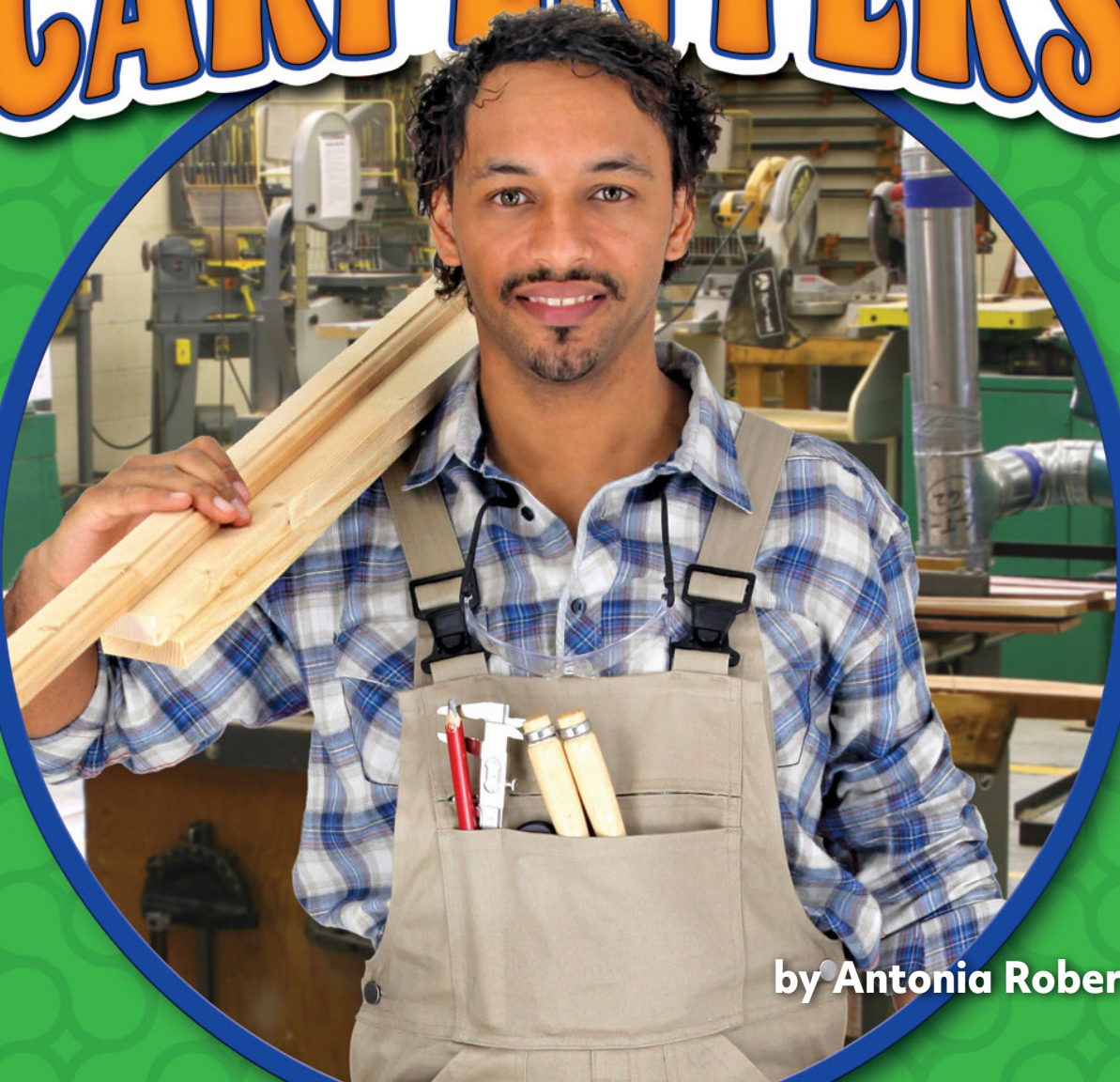

Teaching Tips

Before Reading

- Discuss community helpers. What kinds of roles do these people play in the community?
- Look through the glossary together. Read and discuss the words.
- Go on a picture walk, looking through the pictures to discuss vocabulary and make predictions about the text.

During Reading

- Encourage readers to point to each word as it is read. Stop occasionally to ask readers to point to a specific word in the text.
- If a reader encounters an unknown word, ask them to look at the rest of the page. Are there any clues to help them understand?

After Reading

- Check for understanding.
 - ▶ When would you ask a carpenter for help?
 - ▶ What tools do carpenters use to put pieces of wood together?
 - ▶ What are the power tools listed in this book? What do they do?
- Ask the readers to think deeper.
 - ▶ Why do you think someone might want to become a carpenter?
