


MASSES OF MUMMIES

From around 1870 to 1958, bodies in this Guanajuato (gwah-nah-WAH-toh) graveyard were dug up if the person's loved ones could not afford to pay a fee. Surprisingly, many of the **corpses** had become mummies. They were placed in a nearby building, which later became a museum.
